

THE TOP OFFSHORING PROVIDERS

Earlier this year, The International Association of Outsourcing Professionals (IAOP) was pleased to unveil its first ever ranking of the world's top outsourcing service providers: The Global Outsourcing 100. The list was published in a special advertising feature in the April 3, 2006 issue of FORTUNE® Magazine and is available at the association's website www.outsourcingprofessional.org.

Today, IAOP is equally pleased to unveil the first of more than 20 sub-lists developed from The Global Outsourcing 100 each designed to help companies even better identify top providers

in areas of specific interest to them. This particular list, the Top Offshoring Providers, features outsourcing providers who serve U.S. customers and do so primarily from locations outside the U.S. or Canada.

These companies were selected through an extensive application process covering 18 criteria, including revenue growth, number of employees, the skills and training of their workforce, the number of technical and business certifications they have secured (such as ISO 9001), the track record of the management team, and their quality of customer service.

As might be expected, the vast majority of these companies - 23 of the 30 in fact - are from India. Of the others, 3 are from China, 3 from Eastern Europe or Russia, and one from the Philippines. And although most provide information technology services, many have specialized their services around specific business processes and even business processes for specific industries.
